### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's Degree related to MUSIC, PSYCHOLOGY or HEALTH SCIENCE with at least a 3.0 GPA
- High level of Music Performance Proficiency, especially in piano, guitar and singing.
- English Proficiency Test certificate: TOEFL paper-based score of at least 500; IELTS (academic) score of at least 5.0; or CU-TEP score of at least 60 (attained within the previous 2 years)

### DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- Photograph of the applicant
- Photocopy of the applicant's National ID card (Thai students) or passport (Non-Thai students)
- A copy of official transcript(s)
- A copy of an English Proficiency Test official report
- Completed application form
- Two letters of recommendation (at least one of which must be an academic reference)
- A 750-word essay describing current activities, research interests and future plans
- A curriculum vitae including portfolio of awards and achievements
